

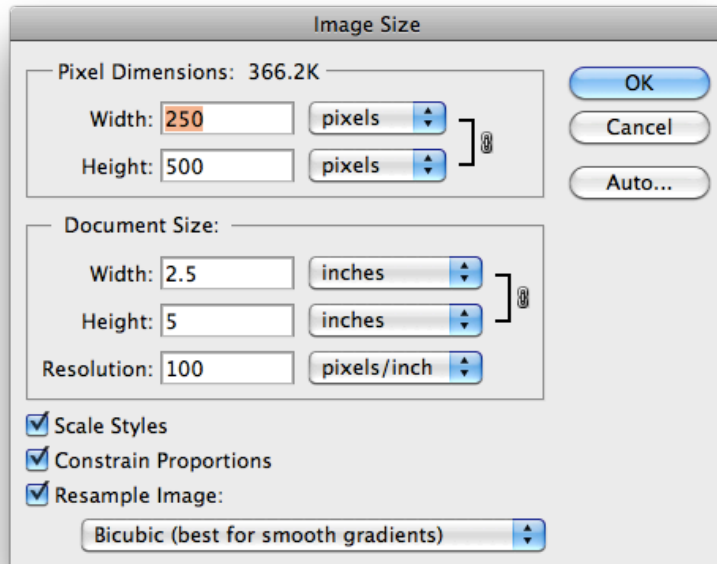

- 2) In Photoshop, set Image Size and/or Canvas size to 250x500 at 100px

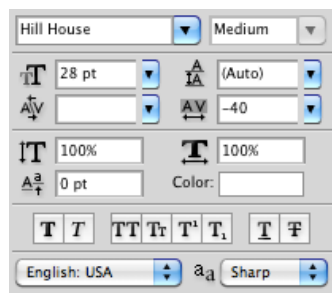
- 3) Open up one of the master files for this genre set (or any of the PS files) and select the Text layer and then select Duplicate Layer and duplicate it over to the new file.
- 4) Select the Text tool and rename the text.

Note: I have a **PS Action** by the same name and a PS Layer style by the same name (for the most part just use the Action to get the entire effect). Click only on the text layer and click the Run button on the bottom bar.

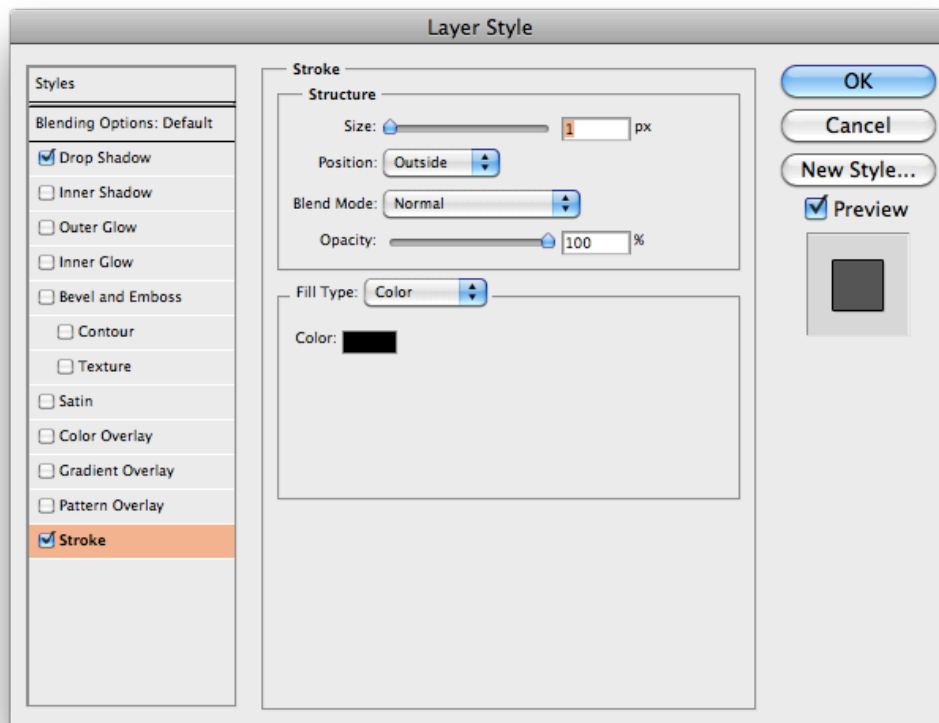
